1. Each Document to be legalize has to be singed by:
  - a. A notary public of your province.
  - b. The signature of the notary must be authenticated by the proper authorities.

2. Once you have obtain both signatures on your document, you must sent it to the Consular Section of this Embassy with the following:
  - a. A Money Order of \$10.00 USD to the name of **EMBASSY OF GUATEMALA** per document signed by the Chamber of Notaries of the Province.
  - b. A prepaid, self-address envelope to return the document to you. (For you own security we recommend express-Post or a courier company of your choice. If you do this by Courier you must provide us with your account number or credit card to cover the courier fees.)
